



GENERAL CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. No liability shall fall on the Organisers, Landowners, Judges or Officials in respect of any loss, damage or injury howsoever caused and all competitors are deemed to be liable to indemnify the said persons in respect of any such loss, damage or injury.
2. Every effort will be made to keep to the schedules, but we reserve the right to alter the order and composition of classes or to cancel them.
3. Any competitor may be warned or disqualified for improper or excessive use of whips, spurs etc. or other actions which the Judges or Officials consider warrants such penalty.
4. Correct riding attire must be worn at all times. ALL RIDERS, whether competing or not, must wear the correct headgear; PAS 015 or BSEN 1384, or prefixed ASTM or SEI are the minimum standard but riders have to be responsible for their own safety. Failure to wear correct headgear will incur elimination. Back protectors are recommended for jumping.
5. The ruling of the judges is final. All complaints must be put in writing and handed to the secretary with a deposit of £10 within 15 minutes of the incident, returnable if the objection is upheld.
6. Entries may be refused without reason being given and there will be no entitlement to any refund of entry unless a class is cancelled due to insufficient entries, or a Medical/Veterinary Certificate is produced. Up to 25% of entry money may be retained to cover administration costs.
7. Change of horse or rider must be notified to the Secretary 15 minutes before the start of the class or the entry will become void. Change of horse and rider will not be accepted
8. ALL DOGS must be kept on leads at all times.
9. Classes will be run under BSA rules except class 1 & 2
10. Rosettes will be awarded to sixth place.
11. Horses and ponies must be 4 years or older to compete.
12. It is the responsibility of competitors to know the rules - our stewards and officials are there to help and advise. Please remember all our helpers are volunteers.
13. A parent/guardian's signature is required on membership and entry forms for any junior and is also required to attend the event with the junior competitor.
14. Members league table points will be allocated as per WORC procedure found on our website.
15. Riders who fall off during the competition may continue riding but do so entirely at their own risk.
16. No outside assistance will be allowed except for class 1 and 2

CLASSES WILL BE RUN UNDER BSJA RULES EXCEPT CLASSES 1 & 2

Class 1 Very small cross poles (40-50cm)

This class is strictly aimed at very novice/inexperienced combinations and will be spilt junior/senior/led/unled if enough entries.

No elimination rule – if you are eliminated you are welcome to continue to the next fence (no fillers will be used in this class)

Assistance/lead rein is permitted

Class 2 Restricted Novice 50cm

This class is strictly aimed at novice/inexperienced combinations and will be spilt junior/senior/led/unled if enough entries.

No elimination rule – if you are eliminated you are welcome to continue to the next fence (no fillers will be used in this class)

Assistance/lead rein is permitted

Class 3 60cm

Class 4 70 cm

Class 5 80cm

Class 6 90cm

Class 7 100cm (If significant entries)

Combinations are only allowed to compete in 2 consecutive classes and are required to enter the classes honestly upon their ability.

Points will be allocated (6 to 1) for placings 1st-6th and will be added to the “Show jumping league table”. The 2 highest combinations will be crowned champion/reserve champion & prizes awarded after the final SJ Series in August, this will open to both members and non-members.

This will be in addition to the member’s league table points.
